

# TAKING YOUR FCA HUDDLE “**DEEP**”

## **D** – **E**EPE**N** your personal walk with God

(Consistent daily quiet time, studying/memorizing the Word, prayer, fellowship, witnessing, “listening” to God in prayer, and obedience) Remember... You can never take people deeper than you are

## **E** – **V**ERYONE “**P**RAYS”

(At “FCA Leadership Team Meetings” pray specifically for “wisdom” in your planning the upcoming meeting, open/teachable hearts for those attending the meeting, “God’s anointing” and for Him to powerfully use the FCA Speaker, for students -by name- to come to faith in Christ, etc.)

## **E** - **V**ERYONE “**P**LANS”

(If you fail to plan, you plan to fail. Determine date, time and place for the next meeting, what “type” of meeting it will be – speaker, video, small group Bible study/discussion, etc. – which officers are responsible for what duties – publicity, music, skit, program, announcements, etc.)

## **P** – **R**AY ‘n **P**RACTICE (“Walk your talk”)

(End your Leadership Meeting by praying for items listed above, specific people, other personal needs) Remember...

- No prayer, no power
- Some prayer, some power
- Much prayer, much power

### **Sample of a 20-30 min. Weekly/Bi-Weekly FCA Leadership Team Meeting**

**5-10 mins.**     **Pray** – pray for wisdom in planning the upcoming meeting...as time allows, each share a “blessing or burden” (this sharing can really “bond” your team)

**10-20 mins.**     **Plan** (see above “Everyone Plans”)

**5-10 mins.**     **Pray** (for God’s Spirit to anoint the speaker, video presentation, Bible study, music, for open hearts/salvation of students by name, for deep growth, etc.) As time allows, ask **each** team member to pray for a specific need mentioned

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**WHO:**            ALL FCA student officers, the adult FCA Huddle Coach (Sponsor), & assistants

**WHY:**            To **pray, plan, and pray**. Remember... “if you fail to plan, you plan to fail.” As your leaders go, so goes your FCA. Your “FCA Leadership Team” will be the **KEY** to the success of your FCA. You can never take people deeper, than you are yourself. “You take care of the **depth** of your life, and God will take care of the **breadth** of your ministry.”

**WHEN:**           Weekly is preferable, or bi-weekly - monthly would be the very minimum. Meeting times: before school, during a lunch period, Saturday breakfast, Sunday afternoon, etc...**whenever** you can get the Leadership Team together

**MISC:**            Include some underclassmen in your officers, so the Seniors can “mentor” them for the **next** school year. Needed materials for “Leadership Team Meetings”: month-at-a-glance calendar (w/ school events, etc.), notebook & pen, blank “Huddle Meeting Plan Sheet” (on other side)
